Teaching Artist Erin Pennell (Rare Hare Studio) ~ Workshop Hours: 10am-3pm

- June 22, 23, 24**      **Forest Fairies and Magical Dwellings:**  
Explore all the special accessories a fairy might use and make a castle or forest dwelling.  
For grades K-5th
- June 27, 28, 29, 30**      **Japanese Aesthetics and Art Making:**  
Discover and practice the art of Japan, including watercolor, origami, kites, and more,  
inspired by nature, and culture. Take a fieldtrip to the Mingei Museum during workshop day.  
For grades: 1st-7th
- July 11, 12, 13, 14**      **Vincent Van Gogh—Color Comes Alive:**  
Dive into the color and texture of Vincent Van Gogh paintings, and create new ways of interpreting his  
work, including working with paint and texture, as well as 3-D projects. Make a painting come alive,  
with more than just paint!  
For grades: 1st-7th
- July 18, 19, 20**      **Drawing A-Z:**  
Practice basic drawing skills and techniques, including drawing from still life and real life. Experiment  
with lettering and words, both on paper and in 3-D forms.  
For grades 2nd-7th
- July 25, 26, 27**      **Extraordinary Creatures:**  
Make creatures in new ways from mixed media, with an emphasis on texture, pattern and form. Choose  
from the animal or dinosaur kingdom or create a creature that no one else has ever seen. Explore collage,  
sculpture, and texture.  
For grades K-5th
- August 8, 9, 10, 11**      **Art Trailblazers—The Art of Alternative Map Making:**  
Discover alternate ways to make maps, using a wide range of materials and process. Maps will vary and  
may take us to new destinations in our imagination. Multi-step process asks the artist to be flexible and take  
their time with each step.  
For grades 1st-7th
- August 22, 23**      **Mini-Rooms and Sustainable Landscape Design:**  
This long-time studio favorite returns! Create your own mini-room, house apartment, office or unique space  
using the gems of creative reuse. This time around artists are asked to consider how to make their space  
more sustainable.  
For grades 1st-7th
- August 25**      **Bring a Book to Life! Teacher Workshop:**  
Teachers can explore taking literacy to a new level by bringing a book to life. Choose your favorite book  
and bring to the workshop to create a unique diorama of the story, characters or scene using mixed media  
and creative reuse. This project inspires teachers to promote their students' visual understanding and  
comprehension of their reading and can be modified for any grade/level.

**Workshop day is 10am-3pm:** Participants bring a lunch, water bottle and \$2 cash daily. All workshops include a local walk and post-lunch ice cream or popsicle. Please bring \$2 cash each day/not included in workshop cost.

**Cost:** 4-day workshop \$250. 3-day workshop \$185. 1-day workshop \$55.
